


Petersham is quietly becoming the Inner West's best borough – a place where inner city thrills meet suburban serenity.


















Sydney, Petersham offers a rich mish-mash of local heritage down every tree-lined street - not to mention the iconic water tower, unmissable in the Petersham skyline.




